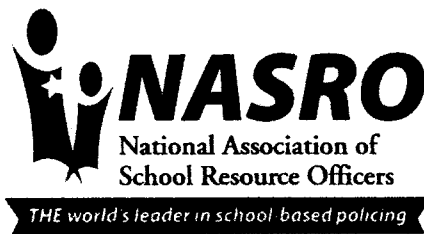

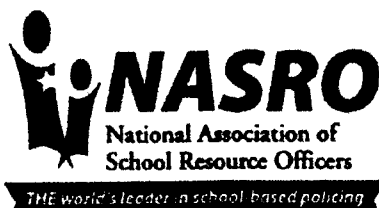

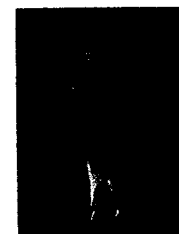
Deputy Chief Michael Beckman, Long Beach Police Department
