COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT PARAMEDIC CARE AND AMBULANCE SERVICES FOR JOHNSON COUNTY ARE AN ITEM NECESSARY TO PRESERVE OR PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH OR SAFETY OF THE RESIDENTS OF JOHNSON COUNTY

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on May 30, 2017 in regular session for the consideration of contracting for paramedic care and ambulance services for Johnson County, Texas and the Commissioners Court finds that a contract for paramedic care and ambulance services for Johnson County is an item necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the residents of Johnson County and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.

A motion was made by Commissioner <u>Kenny Howell</u> and seconded by Commissioner <u>Jerry Stringer</u> that: "The Commissioners Court find that a contract for paramedic care and ambulance services for Johnson County is an item necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the residents of Johnson County and that the Commissioners Court grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code in contracting for paramedic care and ambulance services for Johnson County, Texas and enter an order to that affect".
