#### RESOLUTION NO. 2017-333

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KEENE, TEXAS, EXPRESSING DISSATISFACTION REGARDING THE CONSTRUCTION STATUS OF HIGHWAY 67, AND REQUESTING THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO USE ALL ÁVAILABLE MEANS TO REQUIRE THE COMPLETION OF THE HIGHWAY 67 ROAD WORK AS SOON AS POSSIBLE

WHEREAS, Lone Star Civil Construction, Inc. ("Lone Star"), the contractor selected by the Texas Department of Transportation ("TxDOT") for the widening of Highway 67 to a 4-lane divided highway (the "Project"), was given notice to proceed on December 17, 2013, with a mandated contractual completion date of April 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, as of the date of this Resolution, Lone Star has not completed its work on the Project and continues to work on the Project; and

WHEREAS, TxDOT has imposed liquidated damages on Lone Star for not completing the Project within the contractually-mandated deadline, but has taken no other actions to ensure the expedited completion of the Project; and

WHEREAS, with Highway 67 under construction, vehicle accidents have occurred and will continue to occur in the areas of construction due to the unsafe roadway conditions caused by the construction of Highway 67; and

WHEREAS, the City of Keene, Texas ("<u>Keene</u>"), and its residents are frustrated with TxDOT and its contractor regarding the unexcused delays in the completion of the Project and TxDOT's apparent low prioritization of completing the Project and returning Highway 67 to a safe condition.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KEENE, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The above recitals set forth above are found to be true and correct and are incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.
- <u>Section 2</u>. The Keene City Council hereby expresses its dissatisfaction with TxDOT's contract management of the Project and encourages TxDOT to use all available contractual remedies to require Lone Star to complete the Project as soon as possible.
- Section 3. The Keene City Council encourages TxDOT to make the completion of the Project a top priority in order to promote the public safety and welfare of those driving upon the construction-laden road.

Section 4. Given the public interest in this matter, the Keene City Council requests that TxDOT and Lone Star immediately hold a public town hall style meeting in Keene to give interested persons a forum to be heard and to allow for a meaningful conversation regarding the status of the Project and the resolution of the residents' complaints.

<u>Section 5</u>. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption. City staff is hereby directed to transmit a copy of this Resolution to Texas State Senator Brian Birdwell (District 22) and Texas State Representative DeWayne Burns (District 58), and to any other individuals or entities whom City staff determines may be instrumental in addressing this profound concern for the residents of Keene.
