

The above salaries are to be paid in equal bi-weekly installments out of the General Fund of Johnson County, Texas, effective October 1, 2017.



The above salaries are to be paid in equal bi-weekly installments out of the General Fund of Johnson County, Texas, effective October 1, 2017.





(Effective October 1, 2017)

All Deputy Official Court Reporters shall be paid at the rate of \$351.72 per day, pursuant to Texas Government Code 52.042.


Johnson County will provide stenograph paper and exhibit stickers for all Deputy Official Court Reporters. Deputy Official Court Reporters will provide their own audio tapes and computer disks.

Johnson County will pay mileage for Deputy Official Court Reporter in the amount set by the Commissioners Court for Johnson County employees per County Policy.


INDIGENT CRIMINAL APPEALS



All postage costs will be reimbursed to the Court Reporters in all indigent appeals.


