INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR ROAD CONSTRUCTION AND REPAIR

This agreement is made and entered into pursuant to Chapter 791, Government Code, Vernon's Texas Code Annotated, by Johnson County, Texas, through its Commissioners Court and the City of Alvarado (hereinafter referred to as "City") for the purpose of road construction and repair in Johnson County, Texas and outside the corporate limits of City.

Therefore the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Total charges for this Agreement are detailed on Attachment A-"Schedule of Standard Charges for Interlocal Agreements."
- 2. City will construct or repair roads identified in Attachment B.
- 3. All work will be done in a workmanlike manner as measured by City's usual practice in said work to be performed. City shall be in charge of all control, procedures, means, coordination, and final inspection of this Agreement in regards to said work to be performed.
- 4. Nothing herein shall alter or change the legal responsibility under existing law for a party, nor will this Agreement cause City or Johnson County to incur additional liability other than liability it would have under the law without this Agreement. Neither City nor Johnson County waives any immunity or defense that would otherwise be available to it against claims by third parties.
- 5. This Agreement represents the entire and integrated agreement between Johnson County and City and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations and/or agreements either written or oral. This Agreement may be amended only by written instruments signed by Johnson County and City.
- 6. The validity of this Agreement and of its terms or provisions, as well as the rights and duties of the parties hereto, shall be governed by the laws of the State of Texas.
- 7. In the event that any portion of this agreement shall be found to be contrary to law, it is the intent of the parties hereto that the remaining portions shall remain valid and in full force and effect to the extent possible.
- 8. This Agreement may be terminated at anytime, by either party giving thirty (30) days advanced notice to the other party.

9. The undersigned officer and/or agents of the parties hereto are the properly authorized officials and have the authority to execute this Agreement on behalf of the parties hereto, and each party certifies to the other that any necessary resolutions extending said authority have been duly passed and are now in full force and effect.

Schedule of Standard Charges for Interlocal Agreements Johnson County, Texas
