RE: IAC&ME Annual Training Symposium

I'm writing to request permission to attend the International Association of Coroners & Medical Examiners Training Symposium, July 22-July 26, in Las Vegas Nevada. This training would give me the continued education hours needed for my ABMDI (American Board of Medicolegal Death Investigation) certification.

The IAC&ME 2018 agenda would include training in the investigation in suspicious burns, update on legalized marijuana, new designer drugs, opiates, deadly fentanyl drugs, mass fatality training, and more.

I would like to point out that there are only two courses (that I am aware of) that offer this level of training. The other course is offered through the University of St. Louis. I have attended both in the past, and Las Vegas is a better course by far, is less expensive, and changes its curriculum yearly with the latest in forensic training. The cost for the St. Louis course is 850.00, compared to the 425.00 for the IAC&ME course in Las Vegas. The airfare cost is also less expensive for Las Vegas.
