This training would give me the continued education hours needed for my ABMDI (American Board of Medicolegal Death Investigation) certification.

The IAC&ME 2018 agenda would include training in the investigation in suspicious burns, update on legalized marijuana, new designer drugs, opiates, deadly fentanyl drugs, mass fatality training, and more.

I would like to point out that there are only two courses (that I am aware of) that offer this level of training. The other course is offered through the University of St. Louis. 




