ORDER ESTABLISHING SALARIES

Pursuant to, and with authority therefrom, of the provisions of Chapter 152.005 of the Local Government Code of the State of Texas, we are hereby making the following annual salary adjustments, adopting the Commissioners Court preliminarily approved salary plan for Johnson County employees with the 4% plus \$2,000 and 2% discretionary amount as follows:

- County Auditor, J. R. Kirkpatrick, annual salary of \$114,634 and travel allowance of \$6,739;

- Assistant Auditor, Accountant, Barbara Huneidi, annual salary of \$55,743 and bilingual supplement of \$600;
- Assistant Auditor, Internal Auditor, Rachel Valdez, annual salary of \$43,036;
- Assistant Auditor, Accountant I, Laura Darby, annual salary of \$47,902;
- Assistant Auditor, Accountant Assistant, Sherron Beard, annual salary of \$44,899;
- Assistant Auditor, Accountant Assistant, Heather Daniels, annual salary of \$41,881;
- Assistant Auditor, Accounts Payable Auditor, Cynthia Tanner, annual salary of \$41,156;
- Assistant Auditor, Accounts Payable Auditor, Lori Carlock, annual salary of \$40,305;
- Assistant Auditor, Internal Auditor (part-time), Susan Rossee, wage of \$24.77 per hour.



The above salaries are to be paid in equal bi-weekly installments out of the General Fund of Johnson County, Texas, effective October 1, 2018.



The above salaries are to be paid in equal bi-weekly installments out of the General Fund of Johnson County, Texas, effective October 1, 2018.





FEE SCHEDULE FOR JOHNSON COUNTY COURT REPORTERS
(Effective October 1, 2018)

All Deputy Official Court Reporters shall be paid at the rate of \$353.07 per day, pursuant to Texas Government Code 52.042.

Johnson County will provide stenograph paper and exhibit stickers for all Deputy Official Court Reporters. Deputy Official Court Reporters will provide their own audio tapes and computer disks.

Johnson County will pay mileage for Deputy Official Court Reporter in the amount set by the Commissioners Court for Johnson County employees per County Policy.

INDIGENT CRIMINAL APPEALS

Official Court Reporters and Deputy Official Court Reporters shall be paid \$5.50 per page for an original and two copies on all indigent criminal appeals. Copies of exhibits will be compensated for at the rate of 60 cents per page. The cost of binders and binding, as well as deliveries, will be included in the above per page rates. All postage costs will be reimbursed to the Court Reporters in all indigent appeals.
