Said payment is for a period of April 19, 2019 through May 6, 2019 and is due on April 19, 2019. Lessee agrees to pay at the time of pick up, the amount of the equipment lease as established herein.
- 2. In the event Lessee needs to have a run-off election, this Agreement shall be extended for the time necessary for Lessee to conduct its run-off election upon Lessee's notification to County of the run-off election. Lessee will owe County an additional \$350.00 per voting machine leased by Lessee.
