## Course Description

New for 2019, the Forensic Anthropology and Odontology: Filling the Knowledge Gap Workshop will be a thorough didactic review and hands-on workshop covering the key areas of these topics.

The didactic portion of the course will include topics such as the biological profile construction from skeletal remains, and dental age estimation in sub-adult and adult individuals.
