The Judge went on to comment that in his 25 years the Court has always been responsible, and with the County experiencing a tremendous amount of growth, the goal for this budget year is to lower the tax rate substantially.

Commissioner Bailey and Commissioner Woolley also commented and agreed with the thoughts to reduce the debt rate; which would in turn decrease the tax rate for citizens.

Commissioner Woolley also urged the other taxing entities to look at their budgets and see what they could trim to help the citizens.

County Auditor, Kirk Kirkpatrick addressed the Court to explain the comparison of the tax rates had the 3.5% tax cap been mandated for the upcoming budget year.

Commissioner Stringer addressed the Court to recommend that the Court look at the current employees first, instead of individual line items. Also, he asked if the Court could look at ending all maintenance contracts in the County.

County Extension Agent, Kristen Clark addressed the Court to present her proposed budget for FY 2019-2020.
