JOHNSON CO. CONST. PCT. 4 has adopted a detailed written policy on racial profiling. Our policy:

- 1.) clearly defines acts constituting racial profiling;
- 2.) strictly prohibit peace officers employed by the JOHNSON CO. CONST. PCT. 4 from engaging in racial profiling
- 3.) implements a process by which an individual may file a complaint with the <u>JOHNSON CO. CONST. PCT. 4</u> if th individual believes that a peace officer employed by the <u>JOHNSON CO. CONST. PCT. 4</u> has engaged in racial profiling with respect to the individual;
- 4.) provides public education relating to the agency's complaint process;
- 5.) requires appropriate corrective action to be taken against a peace officer employed by the <u>JOHNSON CO. CONS PCT. 4</u> who, after an investigation, is shown to have engaged in racial profiling in violation of the <u>JOHNSON CO. CONST. PCT. 4</u> policy adopted under this article;
- 6.) require collection of information relating to motor vehicle stops in which a citation is issued and to arrests made a result of those stops, including information relating to:
 - a.) the race or ethnicity of the individual detained;
 - b.) whether a search was conducted and, if so, whether the individual detained consented to the search; and
 - c.) whether the peace officer knew the race or ethnicity of the individual detained before detaining that individual; and
- 7.) require the chief administrator of the agency, regardless of whether the administrator is elected, employed, or appointed, to submit an annual report of the information collected under Subdivision(6) to:
 - a.) the Commission on Law Enforcement; and
 - b.) the governing body of each county or municipality served by the agency, if the agency is an agency of a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state.
