WHEREAS, the Judge of the County of Johnson has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate further spread of the COVID-19 virus; and

WHEREAS, the Judge of the County of Johnson on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2020 issued a Second Amendment to Declaration of Local Disaster Due to Public Health Emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has determined that the Second Amendment to Declaration of Local Disaster Due to Public Health Emergency for Johnson County should continue for a period of more than seven days for the health and safety of the public.
