**COMMISSIONERS COURT APPROVAL OF
COUNTY OF JOHNSON, TEXAS COUNTY JUDGE FOURTH AMENDMENT
TO DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER DUE TO PUBLIC
HEALTH EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Judge of the County of Johnson has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate further spread of the COVID-19 virus; and

WHEREAS, the Judge of the County of Johnson on the 27th day of March, 2020 issued a Fourth Amendment to Declaration of Local Disaster Due to Public Health Emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has determined that the Fourth Amendment to Declaration of Local Disaster Due to Public Health Emergency for Johnson County should continue for a period of more than seven days for the health and safety of the public.

A motion was made by Commissioner Woolley, Pct. #4, and seconded by Commissioner Stringer, Pct. #3, that: "The Fourth Amendment to Declaration of Local State of Disaster Due to Public Health Emergency issued by County Judge Roger Harmon on March 27, 2020, at 2:30 p.m. be continued for a period of more than seven days for the health and safety of the public and that said Fourth Amendment to Declaration of Local State of Disaster Due to Public Health Emergency continue in effect until terminated by the County Judge."

Said motion was approved by a vote of the Commissioners Court on the 31st day of March, 2020.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:






