

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED JOHNSON COUNTY BUDGET FOR 2020-2021

On Monday, September 28, 2020 at 9:00 am at the Johnson County Courthouse, #2 North Main St., Rm. 201, Cleburne, Texas 76033, the Johnson County Commissioners Court will conduct a public hearing for the purpose of receiving public comment on the following issue:

"Proposed County Budget for 2020-2021"

This budget will raise more total property taxes than last year's budget by an amount of \$1,565,418.00 which is a 3.11 percent increase from last year's budget, and of that amount \$2,322,237.00 is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year.

After said public hearing, The Commissioners Court will consider the adoption of the Proposed County Budget for 2020-2021.
