The meeting was called to order at 9:01 A.M. with all members present, except for Commissioner Bailey, Precinct #1, and the following items, having been lawfully posted and filed for record in the office of the County Clerk on November 10, 2020 at 3:51 P.M. were considered:

**I. NEW BUSINESS**

1. CONSIDERATION TO CANVASS THE NOVEMBER 3, 2020 GENERAL ELECTION

County Judge, Roger Harmon noted for Court Record that Commissioner Bailey, Precinct #1 was not present at today's Meeting due to a doctor's appointment.

Comm. Stringer, seconded by Comm. Howell, made a motion to Canvass the votes of the November 3, 2020 General Election and accept the returns as follows: Early Voting 56,694 votes, Ballot by Mail 4,780 votes, Election Day 10,966 votes, for a total of 72,440 votes out of 105,005 Registered Voters.

All voted aye; motion carried.

There being no further business before the Court concerning this agenda, Commissioners Court adjourned at 9:09 A.M.
