RE: Sale of Weapon to Retiring Officer Pete Munoz

Hon. Judge and Commissioners:

Section 614.051 of the Government Code states that an honorably retired peace officer may purchase the firearm that had been previously issued to him(her) for an amount not to exceed fair market value. In order for deputies, currently retiring, to proceed with the purchase of the county-issued firearm, the following price is considered to be in compliance with the statute.

Firearm: Sig Sauer P320 9mm

Price within statutory range: \$400.00

The amount reflects a value within the price range the County would likely obtain for the firearm if sold to a licensed firearms dealer.
