A motion was made by Commissioner and seconded by Commissioner that: The Commissioners Court of Johnson County adopts this order authorizing the sale of fireworks to the public by retail fireworks permit holders during the Memorial Day period beginning Wednesday, May 26, 2021 and ending at midnight Monday, May 31, 2021, subject to the following restrictions:

a. This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, Monday, May 31, 2021, whichever is earlier.

Said motion was approved by a vote of the Commissioners Court on the 12^{th} day of April, 2021.
