Notice to comply with Tax Code Section 26.06 (b-1), 26.06 (b-2), 26.06 (b-3) or 26.061 depending on if the proposed tax rate exceeds the no new revenue tax rate and/or voter-approval tax rate. Tax Code Section 26.062 also requires a table to be included at the end of the notice of the hearing on the tax rate or meeting to adopt the tax rate, as applicable, that compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead this year. Tax Code Section 26.065 requires notice of public hearing on the home page of the County's Internet website at least 7 days before public hearing on the proposed tax rate increase and at least 7 days before the date of the vote proposing the increase in the tax rate.

This vote is in addition to & separate from the record vote to adopt the budget or to set the tax rate. This section also requires an adopted budget to contain a cover page that includes the information set out in Section 111.003 (b)

  L.G.C.

Note: Section 111.008, L.G.C. requires the vote on the budget to be by a record vote of the CC, and the budget must have a cover page that provides the information required by Section 111.008 (d). Section 111.009 (a), L.G.C. requires that the budget must be filed with the County Clerk, and the budget and cover page must be posted on the county's internet website.

Note: Section 26.04 (e-5), T.C. requires county to include as an appendix to the county budget the tax rate calculation forms used to calculate the no-new-revenue tax rate and the voter-approval tax rate. (Effective January 1, 2021).

Note: Sections 26.16 (a) and 26.18, T.C. require certain tax related information and budget related information to be posted on the county's website. (Effective January 1, 2020)

Note: Section 26.05 (a), T.C. requires that the governing body must adopt a tax rate that exceeds the voter-approval tax rate not later than the 71<sup>st</sup> day before the next uniform election date prescribed by Section 4.001, Election Code, that occurs in November of that year. For 2021, the uniform election date is November 2, 2021. Seventy One (71) days prior to Nov. 2, 2021 is Monday, August 23, 2021.

Note: SB 1357, (Signed June 14, 2021, Effective Immediately) amends Sections 111.003 (a), 111.006 (a) and 111.007 (b) and (c), Local Gov. Code and requires county judge to file proposed budget with county clerk no later than August 15<sup>th</sup> and the CC to hold a public hearing no later than 25 days after the proposed budget is filed with the county clerk.

- 2 relating to deadlines associated with proposing and adopting a
- 3 budget for certain counties.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 111.003(a), Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Not later than August 15 [During the 7th or the 10th
- 8 month of the fiscal year, as determined by the commissioners
- 9 court], the county judge, assisted by the county auditor or county
- 10 clerk, shall prepare a budget to cover all proposed expenditures of
- 11 the county government for the succeeding fiscal year.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 111.006(a), Local Government Code, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 (a) Not later than August 15 [When the county judge has
- 15 completed the preparation of the budget], the county judge shall
- 16 file a copy of the proposed budget with the county clerk.
- 17 SECTION 3. Sections 111.007(b) and (c), Local Government
- 18 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 19 (b) The commissioners court shall hold [set] the hearing not
- 20 later than the 25th [for a date after the 15th] day after [of the
- 21 month next following the day [month in which] the budget is filed
- 22 under [was prepared in accordance with] Section 111.006 [111.003,
- 23 Local Government Code, but before the commissioners court adopts
- 24 the county's ad valorem tax rate for the current tax year [date on

- 1 which taxes are levied by the court].
- 2 (c) The commissioners court shall give public notice that it
- 3 will consider the proposed budget on the date of the hearing. The
- 4 notice must state the date, time, and location of the hearing. The
- 5 notice must include, in type of a size at least equal to the type
- 6 used for other items in the notice, any statement required to be
- 7 included in the proposed budget under Section 111.003(b). The
- 8 commissioners court shall give notice under this subsection:
- 9 (1) not earlier than the 30th day before the date of
- 10 the hearing; and
- 11 (2) not later than the 10th day before the date of the
- 12 hearing.
- 13 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a
- 14 budget proposed by a county commissioners court for a fiscal year
- 15 beginning on or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
