Subject: Temporary Inflation Surcharge - Effective May 10, 2021

Dear Valued Customer:

We would like to take the opportunity to thank you for your continued business and support in the current global pandemic times.

Global markets are experiencing unprecedented supply chain disruptions and cost challenges. The resulting impact is higher commodity costs, higher freight fees, and expedition fees across the entire value chain. The increased costs have affected freight shipments, raw materials, electronic components, and other resources that CPI requires in order to provide quality products and services to our customers.

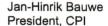
While we strive to manage costs wherever possible and to minimize any price increase to our customers, we find it necessary to address these challenges by implementing a temporary inflation and freight surcharge across our products. Unfortunately, our efforts to improve productivity, efficiency, and reduced energy consumption continue to be outpaced by raw material, unprecedented supply chain disruptions, electricity, production, packaging, and transportation cost increases. There are several specific cost drivers that have impacted CPI:

- 1. Electronic components, semiconductors, and electronic assemblies are experiencing significantly higher demand globally. This is causing higher spot cost premiums being charged to secure adequate supply. This issue is noted across all global industries (e.g. automotive, consumer electronics, industrial).
- Commodity costs have increased on average over 50% in the trailing 12 months. These costs impact the
 raw materials of resin (up 20%), metals (up 92%), PCBs (up 20%) and packaging (up 10%) that comprise
 CPI products.
- Global freight shipment costs have increased over 150% since 2020 with most of this increase occurring since the beginning of 2021. As a global manufacturer and supplier of products, this impacts CPI significantly across our entire supply chain. Container costs have increased from \$3,000 to \$9,000.

CPI has been absorbing all such freight and inflation costs, however, we are no longer able to do so and must pass along a portion of these increased costs. As a result, we will introduce a <u>temporary</u> 3.8% surcharge of the purchase price on all equipment and 5% on spares effective May 10, 2021. The surcharge will not be applicable to existing purchase orders or service costs. In order to lessen the administrative impact, the surcharge will be assessed in the form of a separate line item on invoice.

We will make every effort to communicate any change in a timely manner. Please contact your Sales Manager with your questions or wish to discuss further.
