**COMMISSIONERS COURT GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION
262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING
REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE,
UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT THE
REPRESENTATION BY GRANT BLAIES OF BLAIES & HIGHTOWER, L.L.P.
IS FOR A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE**

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on February 14, 2022 in a regular session for the consideration of representation by Grant Blaies of Blaies & Hightower, L.L.P. in Civil Action No. 3:19-cv-01264-N, Kyra McElvy, et al v. Southwestern Correction, et. al, United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas. The Commissioners Court finds that this representation is for a professional service and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.


A motion was made by Commissioner Howell, Pct. #2 and seconded by Commissioner White, Pct. #3 that: "The Commissioners Court find the representation by Grant Blaies of Blaies & Hightower, L.L.P. is for a professional service and that the Commissioners Court grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, and enter an order to that affect, and that the Commissioners Court approve the representation by Grant Blaies of Blaies & Hightower, L.L.P. in Civil Action No. 3:19-cv-01264-N, Kyra McElvy, et al v. Southwestern Correction, et. al, United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas".


Said motion was approved by a vote of the Commissioners Court on the 14th day of February, 2022.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:




