#### Applicant Meeting Checklist – Huguley and Burleson ISD School Based Clinic

Federal Compliance Expertise: Some experience with School Recovery funds, Title 1 funding

How far in the process are they (procurement issues)?: Do not have an architect yet

Number of people impacted: ~30-40 students working in the clinic per year, estimate ~1200 students being treated

Duration of impact: 50-60 years based on other facility lifespans

Basis for previous two figures: Number based on 32% lunch assistance in the district, duration based on other facilities being rehabilitated

Other grant sources if any: \$8M in School Recovery funds, \$2M in Title 1 funds, 75k in Perkins funds for career/tech education students – primarily spent on tutoring & remedial instruction, additional staff, social/emotional support through counseling staff & curriculum, accelerated instruction through summer for struggling students

Proportion of Services to Johnson County residents: Approximately half, maybe more like 60%, but 75-80% residents, skewed by higher needs in Tarrant County; for this project the high school students working in the clinic would be out of a Johnson County High School.

Details on disproportionately impacted communities where applicable: Focus is on students who don't have health care, 32% economically disadvantaged

#### Project Description:

During the COVID-19 pandemic, Burleson ISD recognized the need for a clinic for the students in the community. Partnering with THR Huguley, a school based clinic would be established for well checks, sick appointments, COVID-19 testing, and childhood vaccinations. Additionally, the clinic will operate as a teaching clinical site for the Health and Science Career and Technology students in Burleson ISD. This will allow the students of Burleson ISD to get the required hours needed for state certification tests, and potentially graduate certified as a Certified Medical Assistant, EKG/ECG Technician, or Phlebotomy Technician. Additional certifications will continue to be offered.

#### Project Budget:

Facility planning is still in the early stages of development. The anticipated budget is approximately 1 million. This would include lead walls for the ability to have x-rays, complete abatement and build out of a 4-6 room clinic.

Project start date is approximately July 2022. Depending on the supply availability we anticipate the job taking 6-12 months.

Funds will be expended within the timeframe of the project, starting July 2022 and continuing the next 6-12 months.
