Thanks for reaching out, I spoke with Josh earlier today and we went over the items below. To somewhat summarize the conversation, I don't believe our impact fee ordinance allows for us to waive impact fees without a council action. However, the cost associated with the impact fees would be \$3802.40 for the 1 ½" meter. The cost of the new tap and meter would be \$1352.75, which could not be waived regardless as that is hardware that we would have to install.
