SPARK Worldwide is a 501 (C) 3 organization in Burleson, TX that is dedicated to serving, protecting and raising kids locally and around the world.

SPARK was founded in 2000 by Leanna Brewer, Co-Pastor of OpenDoor Fellowship. While in Uganda Leanna met a little boy who was orphaned, homeless and hungry. It was then that she knew she had to do something. That's when SPARK was born.

For over 10 years SPARK has provided local children with school supplies and Christmas presents. This year we helped over 300 children have a very merry Christmas!

Mission

The mission of SPARK is to serve, protect and raise kids.

Goal

The goal of the family life center is to provide opportunities for the young people of Johnson County to engage in physical activity to promote good health. A place to stimulate artistic talents with areas of arts and crafts. To encourage a sense of community through mentoring and volunteering. It will be a safe place to build friendships.

SPARK Worldwide

SPARK Worldwide is a 501(C)3 non-profit organization in Burleson, TX that for over 20 years has been dedicated to serving, protecting and raising kids locally and around the world.

When founder, Leanna Brewer, Co-Pastor of OpenDoor Fellowship travelled to Uganda East Africa in 2000 she met a little boy who was orphaned, homeless and hungry. She knew she couldn't walk away and do nothing. What started that day with one little boy has now grown to orphanages, homes, medical clinics and schools on 5 continents.

Locally, SPARK has partnered with OpenDoor Fellowship for over twenty years feeding the hungry and homeless. And for over ten years we have been providing community Easter egg hunts, backpacks with school supplies, Thanksgiving dinners to families and meeting Christmas wish list. Last year we supplied Christmas to over 300 local kids.

Project Description

The multipurpose facility will consist of a 10,000 square foot building that will blend with the aesthetics of the "Old Town Overlay" in Burleson. It will provide a gymnasium floor for court games but can also provide seating area for family game or movie nights. Surrounding two sides of the gymnasium will be community rooms that will have bi-fold doors to allow the rooms to be divided into smaller classrooms for arts, crafts, tutoring or other educational needs. It will also have a cold kitchen, offices, restrooms and storage.

The project will be located at 200 - 212 block of Miller St in Burleson, Tx.

Project Budget

The proposed budget is \$2,220,000.00

Demolishing of existing buildings \$70,000.00

New building \$1,250,000.00

Interior finishes \$600,000.00
