We have been blessed with a new addition to our existing warehouse which allows us double the space for our clients to come in and self select their groceries. We were able to pay for the building and a new walk-in freezer for storage but need the following items to better serve our community.

Used refrigerated box truck with lift. Currently we only have a van which in the Summer is not safe to transport some items and keep them at a safe temperature. We have priced them at about \$50,000.00

- 1- Asber 82" glass door refrigeration unit to use for display/reach in when selecting cold items \$4,416.54
- 1- Kelvinator 81" glass door freezer unit to use for display/reach in when selecting frozen items \$4,729.00
- 1- Kenmore chest Freezer (for specialty items for large families only \$99

Our building is complete, and we plan to open it officially on 5-2-2022
