Cleburne Friends of the Cultural Arts is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit in Johnson County. We operate the JN Long Cultural Arts Center in Cleburne to fulfill our mission to enhance the quality of life in Cleburne and Johnson County by building a strong cultural arts community and increasing public awareness of the arts. We provide a space for over twenty member groups and a hundred member artists to hold meetings and classes. By reducing artists overhead expenses they can make their classes affordable in our community

We host six to eight art exhibits annually along with being the home to the Texas Woodcarvers Guild Museum and a Transportation Museum. We are open for free to the public and attract visitors from across the state.

During 2020 the National COVID Shutdown and continuing concern for public health effectively crippled our operations, including summer art classes. In the summer of 2019 we had 7 instructors, teaching 11 classes to over 300 youth.

While we are surviving as a nonprofit today we still struggle to reinstate some of these programs, including summer art classes. Recovering the financial losses suffered in 2020 would allow us to experience a 'full' recovery and bring these programs back to the community.

JN Long Cultural Arts Center is located at 425 Granbury St in Cleburne. We serve Cleburne and Johnson County and have visitors to our exhibits and museums from across the metroplex.
