ODFP Expansion Project



My name is Barry Gee, and I am the CFO for Open Door Food Pantry (ODFP). ODFP is the largest non-profit (501c3) food bank distribution center in Johnson County. Each year we give away over 4.5 million pounds of food to the residents of Johnson County. ODFP distributes food every other Saturday at 6601 CR 912 for a total of 26 outreaches. ODFP also supplies other food pantries/churches in the Johnson County area.

We would like the opportunity to apply for funding to build and additional 7,500 sq.ft. warehouse with freezers/coolers, concrete for our parking lots, and two additional forklifts. This would allow ODFP to expand our distribution, onsite food storage to prevent spoilage and waste, and to better serve Johnson County and its people. This project will take 9-12 months to complete.


Scope of Work:


To add a second metal building behind the existing Open Door Food Bank Building. This building will be 8000 sq.ft. plus a 30' x 100' awning on the south side. The same R Panel type of construction with 2 -12' rollup doors, 2 - 3'7' metal walk doors, one office and two restrooms.

The building will have a 5" concrete slab with beams. There is approximately 18,000 sq.ft. of concrete flatwork with and additional loading dock. One 30'x 30' walk in frezzer and one 30'x 30' walk in freezer. Purchase of 2 forklifts.
