FY23 20-Hour Justice of the Peace Course Descriptions

Day 1

9:00 AM - 11:00 AM

Court Security – 2 hours (General Session)

Failing to plan is planning for failure! In this day and age it is essential to have a comprehensive plan in place to ensure court security. This course will explain how to develop and implement such a plan and how to make sure the judge, bailiff and all court personnel are familiar with it and prepared to act appropriately should the need ever arise.

11:00 AM - 12:00 PM

Exempt Property Hearings – 1 hour

After recent legislation and new Rules of Civil Procedure, justices of the peace need to follow specific notice requirements in civil cases and also hold exempt property hearings. This course will cover the basics of exempt property in Texas, new notice requirements, and the process for holding exempt property hearings under Rule 679b.

Evictions Scenarios - 2 hours

Evictions can be some of the trickiest cases justice courts deal with. This class will address some of the toughest issues through scenarios on topics including commercial evictions, manufactured home community/RV park issues, appeals, and more.

Criminal Scenarios: Enforcement – 2 hours

They didn't pay! How should courts respond when a defendant does not comply with a criminal judgment? Attendees in this class will discuss various scenarios related to the enforcement of criminal judgments.

1:00 PM - 2:00 PM

Receivership Scenarios - 1 hour

The Supreme Court has modified rules, procedures, and forms related to appointment of receivers to enforce civil judgments. Scenarios will be used to illustrate the changes, as well as to reinforce the basics of receiverships.

Criminal Scenarios: Enforcement (continued)

2:00 PM - 4:00 PM

Procedural Fairness & Diversity in the Courtroom -- 2 hours

Justice court touch the lives of citizens throughout the State of Texas and those experiences can directly affect their trust and confidence in justice in Texas. This class will lead participants through discussions on how justices of the peace and court personnel can understand and expand upon diversity, fairness, and access in Texas justice courts.

The Kids Are Not Alright: Dealing with Juvenile Mental Health Issues - 2 hours

Judges and court staff frequently find that mental health issues in children's homes have an impact on criminal and truancy cases. This course will help judges identify potential mental health issues and craft orders for juveniles to be successful.

Probable Cause—2 hours—TxDot Class

This course will help you understand what probable cause it and why it is so important. It will also review the standards of how to assess a probable cause affidavit and the do's and don'ts when assessing them.

Day 2

8:00 AM - 10:00 AM

Completing Death Certificates--2 hours

Completing death certificates correctly can be hard. This class covers what you need to know when completing death certificates, including how to handle common issues that routinely arise.

Tricky Issues: Small Claims Scenarios - 2 hours

Attendees will work in small groups to discuss how a court should handle tricky issues that could arise in small claims cases. Each group will consider a different complex scenario and then present their conclusions to the rest of the class.

Writs Jeopardy - 2 hours

This class will use a jeopardy format to discuss and explain issues relating to writs for the enforcement of civil judgments, including writs of execution, writs of garnishment, and writs of possession, and will also cover receivership and post-judgment discovery.

10:00 AM - 12:00 PM

Judicial Ethics - 2 hours (General Session)

Judges face a minefield of potential ethical complaints, including contempt, endorsements, fundraising, and use of social media. This class will review the applicable canons of judicial conduct and provide real-world examples of how to stay on the right side of the line.
