Hi Paula,

Here is all the paperwork I can find for the training symposium in Las Vegas for myself and Investigator Tim Melcher. The price of the hotel shows 60.00 per night, however, it is about 49.00 per night with our discount. I checked airfare rates for the dates, and it appears right now the cost would be 364.00 per person roundtrip. We receive the standard meal allowance of 37.00 a day from the county. **The cost of the airfare and hotel will be reimbursed to the county after the conference**. The county will only pay the 450.00 cost (per person) for the course. If you have any questions please contact me.

The purpose of attending the course is to receive the required continued education hours for our ABMDI (American Board of Medicolegal Death Investigators) certification. The IACME (International Association of Coroners and Medical Examiners) puts on an annual training course in Las Vegas, which provides 26 hours of continued education. There is an alternate course that is held in St. Louis at the University of St. Louis, however, it cost approximately 2400.00 per person, with no reimbursement. The course in Las Vegas is much cheaper and is a better course, as I have attended both over the years. Unfortunately, courses in Texas are usually one to three-day courses costing from 75.00 to 500.00 and offer very few continued education hours. The course in Las Vegas covers different topics from year to year and helps us keep up with continued changes in forensics, therefore making us better investigators.
