COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT THE PURCHASE OF A VEHICLE FOR PRECINCT 4 IS A PURCHASE DUE TO A CASE OF PUBLIC CALAMITY (EMERGENCY) AND IT IS NECESSARY TO MAKE THE PURCHASE PROMPTLY TO PRESERVE THE PROPERTY OF THE COUNTY
