Mr. McBroom:

Pursuant to Johnson County Purchasing Manual Section VI. E Emergency Purchases, Subsection (2), I agree that this purchase meets the following criteria:

- The purchase is for less than \$50,000;
- Public calamity, namely COVID-19, has rendered supply chains unstable and made the purchase of vehicles impossible under normal purchasing procedures;
- The purchase is for the benefit of County citizens; and
- The inability to obtain replacement vehicles has resulted in unforeseen wear-and-tear damage to the County's vehicle fleet that can only be remedied by the emergency purchase of replacement vehicles.

Therefore, I consent to the use of emergency purchasing procedures to obtain the vehicle described in the attached quote.

However, payment cannot issue without satisfying any requirements of the Auditor's Office and Treasurer's Office. This email does not authorize the expenditure of unbudgeted funds, which exceeds the authority of this Office.
