COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT THE LEASE OF HVAC EQUIPMENT FROM WALKER ENGINEERING FOR THE GUINN JUSTICE CENTER IS A PURCHASE NECESSARY BECAUSE OF UNFORESEEN DAMAGE TO PUBLIC PROPERTY AND IS AN ITEM NECESSARY TO PRESERVE OR PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH OR SAFETY OF THE RESIDENTS OF JOHNSON COUNTY

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on June 21, 2023 in an emergency called session for the consideration of deliberating the lease of HVAC equipment from Walker Engineering for the Guinn Justice Center as a purchase necessary because of unforeseen damage to public property and an item necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the residents of Johnson County. The Commissioners Court finds that the lease of HVAC equipment from Walker Engineering for the Guinn Justice Center is a purchase necessary because of unforeseen damage to public property and is an item necessary to protect the public health or safety of the residents of the county and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.

A motion was made by Commissioner Woolley, Pct. 4 and seconded by Commissioner White, Pct. 3 that "The Commissioners Court finds that the lease of HVAC equipment from Walker Engineering for the Guinn Justice Center is a purchase necessary because of unforeseen damage to public property and is an item necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the residents of Johnson County and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government

Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code and enter an Order to that effect and that the Commissioners Court approve the lease of HVAC equipment from Walker Engineering.”

Said motion was approved by a vote of the Commissioners Court on the **21ST DAY OF JUNE, 2023.**

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:

The Commissioners Court of Johnson County, Texas does hereby enter this Order granting an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, upon the Commissioners Court finding that the lease of HVAC equipment from Walker Engineering for the Guinn Justice Center is a purchase necessary because of unforeseen damage to public property and is an item necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the residents of Johnson County and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code and enter an Order to that effect and that the Commissioners Court approve the lease of HVAC equipment from Walker Engineering.


