Dear Sir,

I represent a group of Volunteer Deputy Registrars who would like to set up in the Burleson Sub Courthouse and the Cleburne Courthouse Annex to register voters on National Voter Registration Day which is Tuesday, September 19 this year. We would like to use the lobby areas of these facilities from approximately 9 am to 1 pm. We would only take up a corner of the lobby area with only 2 or 3 people manning the table.

Some of us participated in a voter drive last April at the Burleson Sub Courthouse and we found 14 new voters who had come in to register their cars. It was a perfect place to catch the newcomers to our county. We thought that perhaps the same could happen at the Courthouse Annex.

We have also been asked to set up stations at the Burleson and Cleburne Public Libraries. We want our communities to be engaged in the privilege of voting.

As with any voter registration drive that we conduct it would strictly be a non-partisan effort. No political party will be represented. Our purpose is to promote a culture of voting in Johnson County.

If you are willing to invite us to use these county facilities, what would be our responsibilities in setting up? Who should we contact before setting up? Will we be able to use tables and chairs that are on site? Would we have to bring our own? We would have posters that are provided by the National Voter Registration organization which would help to identify our purpose that day.
