City of Alvarado has filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to amend its sewer CCN No. 20360 for the provision of retail sewer utility service in Johnson County, Texas.

<u>The requested area overlaps the district boundaries of Bethany Special Utility District</u>. If these district(s) do not request a public hearing, the Commission shall determine that the district is consenting to the City of Alvarado's request to provide retail sewer utility service in the requested area.

The requested area includes <u>0</u> customer connections, is located approximately <u>3.8</u> mile(s) <u>west</u> of downtown <u>Venus</u>, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>the intersection of Thompson</u> <u>Road and County Road 607</u>; on the east by <u>the intersection of United States Highway 67 and</u> <u>County Road 209</u>; on the south by <u>the intersection of County Road 401 and Ridgeview Lane</u>; and on the west by <u>Percifield Trail</u>.

The requested area includes approximately <u>4,908.9</u> acres, comprised of uncertificated area to amend (add) to City of Alvarado (CCN No. 20360).

The application proposes the addition of approximately 4,908.9 acres to CCN No. 20360.

Persons who wish to intervene in the proceeding or comment upon action sought should contact the Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 13326, Austin, Texas 78711-3326, or call the Public Utility Commission at (512) 936-7120 or (888) 782-8477. Hearing- and speech-impaired individuals with text telephones (TTY) may contact the commission at (512) 936-7136. The deadline for intervention in the proceeding is (30 days from the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later, unless otherwise provided by the presiding officer). You must send a letter requesting intervention to the commission which is received by that date. The letter must include the person's name, address, email address and fax number if applicable.

If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

A landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the requested area, may file a written request with the Commission to be excluded from the requested area ("opt out") within (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the Utility. All opt out requests must include a large-scale map, a metes and bounds description of the landowner's tract of land, landowner's name, address, email address and fax number, if applicable. A landowner that opts out from the requested area releases the applicant's obligation to provide retail water or sewer utility service to the removed land for any reason.

In addition, the landowner must also send a copy of the opt out request to the Utility. Staff may request additional information regarding your request.
