Summary

In accordance with Local Government Code, Section 115, the Auditor's Office performed a review of the County Clerk's "County Courts-at-Law" Cash Bonds for the fourth quarter, July through September 2023 of the 2023 fiscal year. To accomplish this audit, we reviewed Odyssey reports such as disbursement reports and collection reports, and compared them to the bank reconciliation.

Background

The County Clerk's Office serves as clerk and custodian of records for the commissioner's court, constitutional county court and statutory county courts, and hold funds in trust at the direction of the court. Additionally, the office acts as a recorder and custodian of important public records, including all bonds, deeds, birth and death certificates, assumed names and livestock brands, ensuring that records are maintained in a secure, archival manner, and issues marriage licenses.

Scope

Our review was limited to the examination of Odyssey Cash Bond accounts for the County Clerk's "County Courts-at-Law", bank reconciliation reports, and disbursements, for the quarter ended September 2023.

Objective

The objectives of this audit were:

- 1. Ensured compliance with statutory, regulatory, and court requirements
- 2. Evaluated internal controls
- 3. Judgmentally selected case bonds in Odyssey for verification
- 4. Verified the accuracy and completeness of reporting
- 5. Reviewed controls over the safeguarding of assets

Criteria

This is what our fieldwork was measured against.

- 1. Court orders to verify disbursements payee
- 2. Odyssey Trust Owners Account report
- 3. Bank statements supplied by First Financial Bank
- 4. Narrative supplied by County Clerk

Findings

There were no exceptions that would lead us to conclude that the balances and collections of this office for this period were not, in all material respects, appropriately charged, remitted and reported.
