This course is for criminal justice personnel, officers and laboratory technicians who work P with fingerprints and is designed for beginners. No experience is necessary. The objective is to train the student in fingerprint pattern recognition and to compare and identify fingerprints. Instruction on the history of fingerprints, basic physiology of friction ridge formation, the taking of inked fingerprints, basic tools/ methodology used in fingerprint comparison and basic courtroom testimony dealing with enhanced punishment (pen packet testimony) is included.

Note: This course does not include work with latent prints.

Walter is the past-president of the Texas Division of the International Association for Identification and has chaired several committees for the TDIAI.
