Subject: REQUIRED ACTION: Authorized User to Apply for SB 22 Grant

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Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts

A new law provides financial assistance to prosecutors' offices in eligible rural counties to ensure professional law enforcement and legal representation throughout the state (Senate Bill [SB] 22, 88R). The Rural Law Enforcement Grant program can help provide salary supplements to specific employees and funds to hire new staff.

Authorized Users

An approved representative must apply on behalf of a prosecutor's office. For county offices, the user must be the county judge, county attorney or their designee. For the district attorney's office, criminal district attorney's office, or county and district attorney's office - the user must be the prosecutor or their designee. We encourage you to <u>submit the contact information</u> for your approved representative as soon as you are able.

Eligibility and Funding Amounts

Financial assistance is available for counties with populations of 300,000 or less. Funding amounts vary from \$100,000 to \$275,000 depending on population.

Application and Deadline

Eligible counties may apply for grant funds beginning Jan. 1, 2024, regardless of a particular county's fiscal year start-date. The electronic application will be available on the Comptroller's office website beginning Jan. 1, 2024. Applications must be received by Jan. 31, 2024. In future years, counties will apply according to the start of their fiscal years.

If a county's fiscal year has already begun before receiving grant funds, the Comptroller's office will allow "backfilling" funds spent by the county during fiscal 2024 for eligible salary increases or purchases of vehicles and safety equipment.
