Summary

In accordance with Local Government Code, Sections 112 and 115, the Auditor's Office performed a review of the Quick Books (QB) reconciliations for the Special Inventory bank account for the 2023 fiscal year.

Background

The Tax Assessor-Collector assesses and collects ad valorem taxes for Johnson County and other taxing entities. Once the tax rates are set, the property tax statements are sent out yearly in October. Additionally, the Tax Office is tasked with collecting various taxes and fees related to ad valorem, motor vehicles, trailers, boats, beer and wine as well as liquor.

The Special Inventory account is compiled of the taxes due on the actual inventory the dealerships have on hand at the end of each quarter, for RV's, campers and trailers.

Scope

Our review was limited to the examination of the Tax Office QB's reconciliations for Special Inventory, to bank statements, for this period.

Objective

To accomplish this audit, we examined the QB reconciliation reports, all outstanding deposits, any un-cleared checks, and the bank statements for each month from October 2022 through September 2023.

Findings

There were no exceptions that would lead us to conclude that the balances and collections of the office for this period were not, in all material respects, appropriately charged, remitted, and reported.
