ORDER DECLARING PROPERTY SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING DONATION TO A CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION PURSUANT TO TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE § 263.152 (a) (4)

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on this date in regular session for the consideration of determining certain personal property belonging to the County is surplus property with only nominal monetary value. The said property is approximately 50 issues of the Southwestern Historical Quarterly publication.

A motion was made by Commissioner Howell, Pct. 2 and seconded by Commissioner White, Pct. 3 that: "Johnson County finds that undertaking to sell the aforementioned property by auction would likely result in no bids or a bid price that is less than the County's expenses required for the bid process, the donation of the property to a charitable organization within the County serves a public purpose, and the recipient of the property is providing adequate consideration for the property by relieving the County of the costs associated with storing, transporting, and/or disposing of the property; and further moves to declare the property surplus and authorize the donation of the property to the Friends of the Johnson County Historical Commission, a charitable organization within Johnson County."



NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:






