### Summary

In accordance with Local Government Code Section 115, the Auditor's Office performed a review of the Sheriff's Office Escrow Account for the period ending September 2023.

### Background

The Sheriff's Office is responsible for traffic control, investigating crimes, apprehending fugitives, running the county jail, emergency response calls (911), resolving disputes, executing warrants, security of the court's buildings, and the safety and security of the Judges. The Sheriff's Office assists other law enforcement agencies within the county.

### Scope

Our review was limited to the examination of the Sheriff's Office Escrow ledger accounts, disbursements for the quarter ended September 2023. To accomplish the audit, we examined bank reconciliations and supporting documents; reviewed Odyssey receipts and related procedures; and verified that funds collected had been accurately and timely disbursed.

# Objective

Compared bank reconciliations and supporting documents, and Odyssey receipts and related procedures were reviewed. All outstanding deposits and any un-cleared checks on the reconciliation reports were compared to the deposit reports, and to the First Financial bank statements for each month from July, August and September 2023.

### Findings

There were no exceptions that would lead us to conclude that the balances, collections and disbursements for this period were not, in all material respects, appropriately charged, remitted and reported.
