ORDER EXTENDING DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER (MAY 5, 2024 FLASH FLOOD EVENT)

WHEREAS, Johnson County experienced rapid, wide-spread, and unexpected flooding beginning on May 5, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Johnson County Judge Christopher Boedeker, on the 6th day of May, 2024, issued a Declaration of Local State of Disaster; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Government Code Chapter 418, the Judge's Declaration of Local State of Disaster is set to expire at 11:59 p.m. on May 13, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has determined that the Declaration of Local State of Disaster for Johnson County should continue for a period of more than seven days for the health and safety of the public.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that, to promote the health and safety of the citizens of Johnson County, the Declaration of Local State of Disaster issued by Johnson County Judge Christopher Boedeker on May 5, 2024 shall be extended until terminated by the County Judge.

DECLARATION A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the County of Johnson on the 6th day of May, 2024 has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life and property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from Wide-Spread, Unexpected Flooding from May 5, 2024 through the present time and;

WHEREAS, the Judge of County of Johnson has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE JUDGE OF THE COUNTY OF JOHNSON:

1. That a state of disaster is declared for the City/County of Johnson.
2. That the County's Emergency Management Plan has been implemented.
3. That this state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days of the date hereof, unless the same is continued by consent of the Commissioners Court of the County of Johnson, Texas.
4. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
