COUNTY OF JOHNSON

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COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT THE WORK PERFORMED BY INDIVIDUALS FOR CONSTRUCTING CONCRETE FORMS AND CONCRETE FINISHING FOR PRECINCT 1 IS WORK PERFORMED AND PAID FOR BY THE DAY AS THE WORK PROGRESSES

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on May 13, 2024 in regular session for the consideration of nine to ten individuals to construct concrete forms and concrete finishing for Precinct 1. The Commissioners Court finds that the work performed by the nine to ten individuals in constructing concrete forms and concrete finishing is work performed and paid for by the day as the work progresses and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED:

The Commissioners Court of Johnson County, Texas does hereby enter this Order granting an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, upon the Commissioners Court finding that the work performed by the nine to ten individuals in constructing concrete forms and concrete finishing for Precinct 1 is work performed and paid for by the day as the work progresses.
