**COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT THE PURCHASE OF A VEHICLE FOR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT IS A PURCHASE DUE TO A CASE OF PUBLIC CALAMITY AND IT IS NECESSARY TO MAKE THE PURCHASE PROMPTLY TO THE PRESERVE THE PROPERTY OF THE COUNTY**

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on May 13, 2024 in regular session for the consideration of a purchase for Emergency Management of a Ford F-250 truck from Cleburne Ford. The Commissioners Court finds that this vehicle purchase is a vehicle that must be purchased in a case of public calamity and it is necessary to make the purchase promptly to preserve the property of the county and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED:**

The Commissioners Court of Johnson County, Texas does hereby enter this Order granting an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, upon the Commissioners Court finding that the purchase of a Ford F-250 truck from Cleburne Ford is a vehicle that must be purchased in a case of public calamity and it is necessary to make the purchase promptly to preserve the property of the county and that the Commissioners Court grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.
