COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT VOTEC CORPORATION IS THE ORIGINATOR AND OWNER OF THE POLLPOWER/VOTESAFE SOFTWARE SYSTEM AND WELCOMEVOTER KIOSKS AND IS A SERVICE FOR VOTING IN JOHNSON COUNTY THAT CAN BE OBTAINED FROM ONLY ONE SOURCE

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on July 8, 2024, in regular session for the consideration that VOTEC Corporation is the originator and owner of the PollPower/VoteSafe software system and WelcomeVoter Kiosks and is a service for voting in Johnson County that can be obtained from only one source, and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code as no other company can provide the PollPower/VoteSafe software system and WelcomeVoter Kiosks for voting in Johnson County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED:

The Commissioners Court of Johnson County, Texas does hereby enter this Order granting an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, upon the Commissioners Court finding that VOTEC Corporation is the originator and owner of the PollPower/VoteSafe software system and WelcomeVoter Kiosks and is a service for voting in Johnson County that can be obtained from only one source.
