WHEREAS, on February 11, 1971, Deputy Robinson made the ultimate sacrifice in service to the citizens of Johnson County, losing his life in the line of duty while protecting and serving our community; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Robinson's sacrifice serves as a lasting reminder of the dangers faced daily by the brave men and women of law enforcement who protect and serve our community; and

WHEREAS, the Center serves as the vital communications hub for emergency response in Johnson County, coordinating the efforts of law enforcement, fire services, and emergency medical response; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to honor Deputy Robinson's memory and sacrifice by naming this essential public safety facility in his honor, ensuring that his legacy of service and sacrifice will be remembered by future generations; and

WHEREAS, the name of this facility will serve as a daily reminder to all who enter into the profound sacrifices made by law enforcement officers in service to our community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF JOHNSON COUNTY that the Johnson County Emergency Communication Center shall henceforth be known as the
