AT THE SAME TIME you submit your registration form to TCRA (either online or via email) we MUST ALSO receive proof of the PO/request form that you have submitted to your county requesting payment. This should be emailed to: TCRAHQ@EMBARQMAIL.COM.

We must receive this information by the cut-off date of the pricing window you've selected in order to honor those fees. Otherwise, the rate will increase - EEK!!!

<u>DO NOT rely on your county to notify us of your registration details.</u> They typically do not forward registration forms to us and mail only the check, which may take several weeks/months for us to receive, and we must have proof in advance of your attendance and their intent to pay in order to honor the registration fee you signed up for.
