PROCLAMATION RECOGNIZING THE 2025 GRANDVIEW HIGH SCHOOL LADY ZEBRAS SOFTBALL TEAM – 3A DIVISION I STATE CHAMPIONS

WHEREAS, the Johnson County Commissioners Court proudly recognizes and celebrates the achievements of outstanding student-athletes who exemplify excellence, determination, and sportsmanship; and

WHEREAS, the 2025 Grandview High School Lady Zebras Softball Team displayed unmatched dedication, discipline, and teamwork throughout an extraordinary season, culminating in capturing the UIL Class 3A Division I State Championship—the first softball state championship in school history; and

WHEREAS, the Lady Zebras compiled an incredible 35-3 overall record, going a perfect 10-0 in district play and 10-0 in the playoffs, and defeating Whitesboro by a score of 9-3 in the state championship game on May 29, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the 2025 Lady Zebras finished ranked 6th in the state across all classifications, and earned a third consecutive appearance at the state tournament, setting a new standard for Grandview High School softball; and

WHEREAS, under the exemplary leadership of **Head Coach Leigh Ebner**, in her fourth year at Grandview after 22 years at Hill College, the Lady Zebras demonstrated championship-level coaching, strategy, and development; and

WHEREAS, the team received exceptional contributions from student-athletes including:

- Junior pitcher Madi Doty, named State Championship Game MVP,
- Freshman catcher Kenna Collins,
- Sophomore first baseman KJ Hubbard,
- Senior shortstop Jaley James,
