

FIDELITY NATIONAL TITLE

Being all that certain lot, tract or parcel of land lying and being situated in the E. Melton Survey, Abstract No. 618, Johnson County, Texas and being a portion of Lot 20 of Cross Timbers Estates, an Addition to Johnson County, Texas, according to the Plat thereof recorded in Volume 4, Page 59, Plat Records, Johnson County, Texas (P.R.J.C.T.) and being the same land described in deed to David M. Finley, recorded in Book 2062, Page 862, Deed Records, Johnson County, Texas (D.R.J.C.T.) and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a 1/2 inch iron rod found for corner in the Northeast line of a 60 foot Roadway and Utility Easement (County Road 308B), at the East corner of that portion of said Lot 20 described in deed to Jerry W. Putty and Cynthia Lorene Putty, recorded in Book 1955, Page 675 (D.R.J.C.T.), also being in the Southwest line of Hillcrest Estates, an Addition to Johnson County, Texas according to the Plat thereof recorded in Volume 4, Page 20, (P.R.J.C.T.);

THENCE South 30 degrees 07 minutes 29 seconds East, with the said Northeast line of County Road 308B, a distance of 177.61 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod found for corner at the common East corner of said Lot 20 and Lot 19 of said Addition:

THENCE South 59 degrees 28 minutes 31 seconds West, passing a 1/2 inch iron rod found for reference, a distance of 59.80 feet and continuing a total distance of 489.27 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod found for corner in the Northeast line of a tract of land described in deed to Jerry L. Donathan, recorded in Volume 1007, Page 211 (D.R.J.C.T.), at the West corner of said Lot 19;

THENCE North 30 degrees 31 minutes 29 seconds West, a distance of 177.61 feet to a point for corner in the Northeast line of Lot 26R2 of Cross Timbers Estates, an Addition to Johnson County, Texas, according to the Plat thereof recorded in Volume 8, Page 405 (P.R.J.C.T.), from which a 1/2 inch iron rod found for reference bears South 27 degrees 46 minutes 18 seconds West, a distance of 0.48 feet;



a. <u>CROSS TIMBERS ESTATES-PRELIMINARY REPLAT OF LOT</u> #20 into Lot #20A and #20B - Pct. #4
