HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE

TITLE 9. SAFETY

SUBTITLE B. EMERGENCIES

CHAPTER 779. AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS

Sec. 779.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "automated external defibrillator" means a heart monitor and defibrillator that:

(1) has received approval from the United States Food and Drug Administration of its premarket notification filed under 21 U.S.C. Section 360(k), as amended;

(2) is capable of recognizing the presence or absence of ventricular fibrillation or rapid ventricular tachycardia and is capable of determining, without interpretation of cardiac rhythm by an operator, whether defibrillation should be performed; and

(3) on determining that defibrillation should be performed, automatically charges and requests delivery of an electrical impulse to an individual's heart.

Sec. 779.003. ACQUISITION, MAINTENANCE, AND INSPECTION OF AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR. A person or entity that owns or leases an automated external defibrillator shall:

(1) maintain and test the automated external defibrillator according to the manufacturer's guidelines; and

(2) conduct a monthly inspection to verify the automated external defibrillator:

(A) is placed at its designated location;

(B) reasonably appears to be ready for use; and

(C) does not reasonably appear to be damaged in a manner that could prevent operation.



Sudden Cardiac Arrest Chain of Survival



Employee had returned to his work area just after morning break, when he collapsed. Co-workers immediately came to his aid and determined this was heart related and put out calls for EMS and to retrieve AED. Chest compressions started approximately 90 seconds after initial contact.

Physician's Notes

This patient suffered a witnessed collapse due to sudden cardiac arrest. The response by staff was outstanding, and in this case, clearly life-saving. EMS was quickly contacted, CPR was immediately administered, and the AED was brought to the scene within minutes. The AED functioned correctly. Ventricular fibrillation was correctly identified, and a defibrillating shock was given less than 4 minutes after the collapse. This rapid time to defibrillation is the most important factor in achieving a good outcome. The first shock was not successful in restoring an organized cardiac rhythm. CPR was continued, and the AED performed a second analysis 2 minutes later. Ventricular fibrillation persisted and a second shock was given. The second shock restored an organized cardiac rhythm and the patient is reported to have survived. You and your responding staff should be commended for the outstanding care provided.

This case represents the 314th life saved in the Save More Lives Network since 2011!
