MOTION by Comm. White, seconded by Comm. Bailey, to approve as presented.

All voted aye; motion carried.

- A2.** Discuss and Take Action to Adopt an Order Authorizing Defeasance and Redemption of Approximately \$120,000.00 of Johnson County, Texas General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Taxable Series 2021; Levying Ad Valorem Taxes in Payment Thereof; and Enacting all Matters Incident or Related Thereto-Auditor's Office

County Judge Christopher Boedeker presented.

Auditor Steve Watson presented.

Judge Boedeker stated that he needed two separate motions. He called initially for a motion on **Order 2025-73**.

MOTION by Comm. Howell, seconded by Comm. White, to approve what the Judge just read.

MOTION by Comm. Bailey, seconded by Comm. Howell, to approve to maintain the fees.

County Attorney Bill Moore asked if there was an effective date.

Comm. Woolley stated that it was effective October 1.

All voted aye; motion carried.

The Commissioners Court convened into Workshop Session at 9:12 A.M. to discuss WS1.

WS1. Discussion of Budget and Tax Rate

Comm. Woolley noted that not all constables shared the same views regarding the discussion of significant raises.
